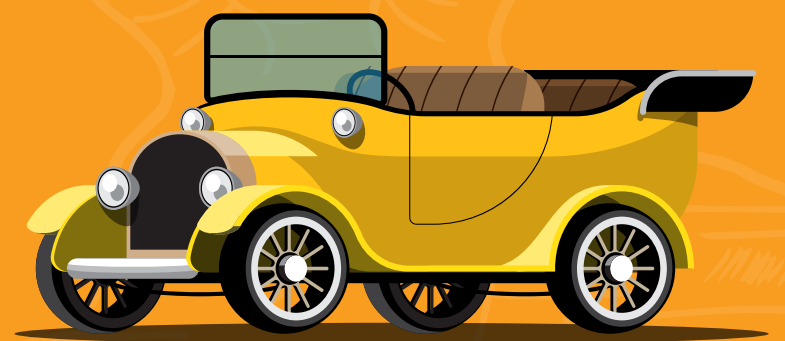

TOP 5 MUST-SEE MUSEUMS IN SOUTH AFRICA

1. THE FRANSCHHOEK MOTOR MUSEUM, WESTERN CAPE

The museum is currently home to over 200 cars ranging from the 1898 Beeston Motor Tricycle to the 2003 Enzo supercar.



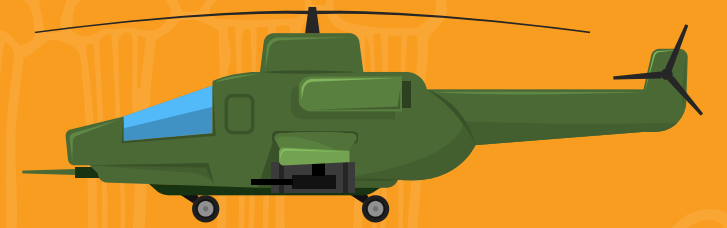
2. DITSONG NATIONAL MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY, GAUTENG

This museum is home to many tourist attractions such as its giant dinosaur skeletons and magnificent sandstone walls.



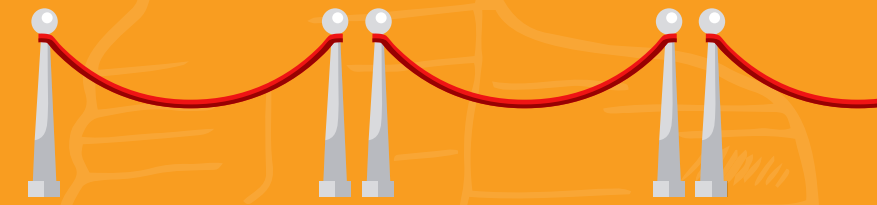
3. THE ALBANY MUSEUM, EASTERN CAPE

This museum consists of seven different buildings, the natural sciences museum, the history museum, the observatory museum, the fort Selwyn, the old provost military prison, the Drostdy arch, and the old priest's house.



4. THE NATIONAL MUSEUM, FREE STATE

The National Museum contains 13 research departments and 2 technical departments that host many exhibits covering a wide range of different subjects.



5. THE KIMBERLEY MINE MUSEUM, NORTHERN CAPE

The museum takes its visitors back in time, recreating what it was like to live in a mining town. The museum is also situated near the infamous Big Hole.
