




# WORLD JELLYFISH DAY

## JELLYFISH RACE GAME

### WHAT YOU'LL NEED – GET AN ADULT TO HELP

- 3 or more storage bins.
  - String.
  - Clear sellotape.
  - Pack of blue metallic crinkle paper (or you can use used paper, paint it blue and cut into strips).
  - Fake jellyfish - you can make these with inflated ziplock bags.
  - Spray bottles - be sure to adjust the nozzle so that the water comes out in a stream.
  - Access to a nearby hose, or buckets to fill with water and carry.
  - Table to put bins on.
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### HOW TO PUT IT TOGETHER:

1. Make the starting line – you can attach string horizontally across the one side of the storage bin.
2. Make the finish. Attach pieces of “metallic crinkle” or your blue used paper across the width of the other side of the bin with your sellotape.
3. Place the bins on a table, and fill them a little less than halfway with water, adding a few drops of blue food coloring if desired. Also fill the spray bottles with water.

### TO PLAY:

Place your jellyfish before your starting line.

Make sure that the spray bottles are all set to a stream.

Have the kids line up behind each bin (one line per bin). The children positioned first in each line will “race” one another by spraying the jellyfish from the starting line all the way to the open ocean (finish line).

Once the first set of racers have completed the race, they can pass the spray bottle to the person behind them. They will definitely want another turn, so they can keep getting back in line!
