HOW TO IMPROVE YOUR LISTENING SKILLS IN THE CLASSROOM

1. KEEP EYE CONTACT WITH YOUR TEACHER

Looking at your teacher during the lesson will limit the amount of distractions in your view. This will help you concentrate on what they are saying.

2. PAINT A VISUAL PICTURE OF WHAT YOUR TEACHER IS SAYING

Trying to create a visual image of what your teacher is saying will help you retain the information.

3. DON'T INTERRUPT

Wait for your teacher/fellow learner to finish talking before you respond.

4. ASK IF YOU DON'T UNDERSTAND

If there is something you aren't sure of, raise your hand and ask your teacher to explain.
