




All the waste from the people's activities was causing so much damage. Pollution from the buildings was running into the water, making it dirty and unhealthy.

Manzi knew that, if nothing was done about it, the natural resources, which all living things need for life, would start to disappear.




- I. What caused the damage that Manzi saw?

Manzi was very sad to see so much pollution in the water and in the air. It made him want to cry.




- I. What do we call the place where the river meets the sea?

"I will teach them to become Water Wise Warriors."




- I. What did Manzi want people to understand?



- Take Environmental Action.




