

Stingrays breathe through their gills. They have spiracles (holes) that open when they are not swimming to allow water to pass over the gills so they can breathe.

Stingrays have a much smaller pectoral width.

Stingrays grow to be 1-2 meters.

Has a spine for protection.



Manta rays breathe through their gills. Water passes in through their mouth over their gills and out through the gill slits.

Manta rays have a wider pectoral width.

Manta rays can grow up to 9 meters.

Has no spine for protection.
